


## Marching into Spring Break!

The [Chesapeake Beach Railway Museum](#) is located in the original Chesapeake Beach Railway train station. It features artifacts exploring the history of the former railway and Chesapeake Beach as a resort destination in the early 20th century. Events include children's programs and summer concerts.

[Kings Landing Park](#), a 260-acre jewel on the Patuxent River, has a fishing pier, hiking trails, an equestrian facility and canoe and kayak access to the river.



Calvert Library offers complimentary or reduced-price passes to more than 20 participating community partners, including museums, wineries, parks and more. All you need is a library card!



The [Port Republic One-Room Schoolhouse #7](#), built around 1868, is available for tours by appointment.

Tour the 100-acre [Battle Creek Cypress Swamp Sanctuary](#) and see ancient bald cypress trees, enjoy bird watching and take nature walks. Come inside to see the amazing albino snapping turtle and other animals.



On [Calvert Marine Museum](#) First Free Fridays, the Calvert Marine Museum is open to the public 5-8 p.m.

Explore [Jefferson Patterson Park and Museum](#) along the Patuxent River with 66 archaeological sites, self-guided trails and a visitor center with museum exhibits, a children's discovery room and a museum shop. While there, tour the [Maryland Archaeological Conservation Laboratory](#) featuring artifacts of Maryland's heritage.

New tastes abound throughout Calvert County on Saturday, March 24, when visitors and locals alike enjoy eating all the local foods that make us famous - all day long.



Start your day at Calvert County's fourth annual Farm to Table breakfast at the Calvert County Fairgrounds. From 7-10:30 a.m., local farmers share, prepare and serve delicious food from their own homemade ingredients. Fresh sausage and bacon,

biscuits kneaded from this year's crop of wheat, jams from Calvert County's strawberry fields and milk and homemade butter straight from the cow make this old-fashioned community feast one to remember.

Hosted by the Calvert County Farm Bureau, this event is a way of sharing with the community the importance of agriculture and the deep-rooted traditions still practiced by Calvert County's farmers. Tickets are \$12 in advance and \$15 at the door.

### ***... and Taste of Solomons Lunch***

Save room for life off the farm! Just minutes south and just in time for lunch, restaurants sprinkled throughout historic Solomons will showcase selected food and beverages during the celebrated annual one-day Taste of Solomons food festival from 11 a.m. to 4 p.m.


