A Beach of History

Drum Point Lighthouse



The Drum Point Lighthouse was constructed in 1883 on five acres of submerged land about one-sixteenth of a nautical mile due south from Drum Point. This screw pile, cottage-type light is one of three remaining from 45 that once served the Chesapeake Bay at the beginning of the 20th century. It is a white, hexagonal wooden structure, with a wrought iron screw pile base. A red light was fixed 15 feet high and could be seen for 13 nautical miles in clear weather. In poor weather, the fog bell would ring a double blow every 15 seconds. Keepers were required to make daily entries regarding weather, work performed and any unusual occurrences. Logbooks for the Drum Point Lighthouse have survived for the periods 1883 to

1943, and are preserved at the National Archives. In 1962, the lighthouse was decommissioned and became the target of vandalism. In 1975, it was moved to its current location at Calvert Marine Museum. Upon the move, the lighthouse underwent a large restoration and renovation project and is now complete with furnishings of the early 20th century. The Drum Point Lighthouse is open year-round. 
