Election Day 2020 – Tuesday, Nov. 3



Thank you to everyone who has already made their voice heard and voted in the 2020 general election. Every vote counts! If you haven't yet made it to the polls, please remember voters are required to wear adequate face coverings and observe physical distancing. Below is additional information for voting this year.

EARLY VOTING

Early voting is open through Monday, Nov. 2 at the following location:

Calvert County qualifies for only one early voting center, which is determined by the state based on voter population. It is the Election Board's priority to safeguard the health, safety and accessibility needs of voters. If you are unable to wait in line, there will be assistance available.

DROP BOXES

Secure drop boxes will be available 24/7 until 8 p.m. on Tuesday, Nov. 3. Ballots are retrieved daily by Board of Elections staff at the following locations:

VOTE CENTERS

Calvert County will have five vote centers open on Election Day, Nov. 3, 2020. Calvert County residents may go to the vote center that is most convenient for them. The polls will be open from 7 a.m. to 8 p.m. at the following locations:

MAIL-IN BALLOTS

There is still time to return your mail-in ballot. If returning by mail, your ballot must be postmarked by Tuesday, Nov. 3 and received by Friday, Nov. 13. With reports of USPS delays, election officials urge voters with mail-in ballots to use drop boxes.

Local Resources for Children and Adolescents

Calvert County Family Network is Calvert County Government's Local Management Board (LMB), under the Department of Community Resources. This year, the LMB is funding Southern Maryland Community Network to provide Trauma-Focused Cognitive Behavioral Therapy for children and adolescents, with a special focus on those impacted by incarceration. This is an evidence-based treatment option for children diagnosed with Post Traumatic Stress Disorder, that provides additional support to parents/caregivers. The LMB also facilitates the Calvert County Local Care Team (LCT), an interagency team that works collaboratively to provide families of youth with intensive behavioral health needs the necessary resources for success. Families can self-refer for children of all ages, and up to 21 years old if they are still in school.
