SUBJECT: Adequate Public Facilities Report for Schools – December 5, 2011

Background:

The Zoning Ordinance states in Article 7-1.05 D.1 that “Schools are adequate when all public elementary and secondary schools which will serve the proposed residential subdivision or residential development will accommodate the pupil yield from that residential subdivision or residential development without exceeding 100 percent of the rated capacity of any of those schools.”

The Calvert County Zoning Ordinance, Section 7-1.05 E states, “If facilities are identified as having inadequate capacity, the Department of Planning and Zoning shall notify the Planning Commission and the County Commissioners.”

Discussion:

In the April 4, 2011 report staff reported that three of the four high schools were over 100% capacity and Patuxent High School was the only high school below 100% capacity. As a result, a majority of the county was closed to the recording of subdivisions and residential site development plans, except for areas served by Patuxent High School. The updated information, outlined in the attached charts, continues the below capacity trend at Patuxent High School and, furthermore, identifies Calvert High School below 100% capacity as well. Northern High School and Huntingtown High School remain above 100% rated capacity.

Parcels that meet certain criteria listed in the Zoning Ordinance are exempt from APF Requirements for Schools (Section 7-1.05. F). Determination of school adequacy is not required for non-residential subdivisions or age-restricted housing communities. The Zoning Ordinance limits the delay of final approval of a residential subdivision or residential development to seven years.

Of Calvert County’s 23 public schools, five (5) are deemed inadequate since enrollments exceed 100% of the County’s Adequate Public Facilities (APF) rated capacities for those schools. These same four schools were over capacity in the fall. The following two (2) elementary schools, one (1) middle school and two (2) high schools have inadequate capacities:

The Calvert County Public School staff provided the enrollments for September, 2011, the number of elementary school classrooms, the number of middle and high school teaching stations, and the Career and Technology Academy attendance (see attachments). The chart showing the calculation for each school's APF rated capacity is attached. The calculations for determining the elementary, the middle, and high school APF rated capacities are specified in the Calvert County Zoning Ordinance.

Maps are provided for elementary, middle, and high school levels and the report includes a composite map of all school levels that are over 100% capacity (attached). The maps are for illustrative purposes. The Board of Education's written descriptions of school district boundaries determine which school districts serve a residential subdivision or residential development. If there is a question regarding which school district serves a parcel, the Board of Education makes the final determination.

Elementary Schools

Of the 13 elementary schools, two are over 100% APF capacity: Beach (114.2) and Mount Harmony (101.1%). With two exceptions, the remaining elementary schools are below 90%. There are two elementary schools, Dowell and Windy Hill, that are over 90% but less than 100% capacity.

Middle Schools

One of the six middle schools, Northern Middle, is over capacity at 105.8%. The remaining middle schools are less than 90% capacity.

High Schools

Two (2) high schools, Northern High School and Huntingtown, are over 100% capacity. The remaining two high schools are between 98% to 100% capacity.

Student Transfer Analysis:

In August 2011, the County Commissioners requested staff include an evaluation of the impact of student transfers on the County School capacities in future Adequate Public Facilities Report. In this report, Staff included a chart, entitled *Enrollments Compared with APF Rated Capacities Transfer Students*, evaluating transfer student impacts by subtracting the number of incoming students and adding the number of outgoing students. The chart indicates that Mt. Harmony Elementary School could no longer be over capacity if student transfers were not considered. This analysis affirms that Northern High School continues to remain above capacity. Since Northern High School remains over capacity, the area district would not be affected by the transfer student policy. In addition, the chart identifies that Huntingtown High School would actually be below capacity without the transfer student policy.






