ACLT is a member-supported, non-profit that protects the Parkers Creek watershed and its surrounding natural lands, waterways, and wildlife habitats. With more than 3,200 acres of protected land, ACLT has built and maintains 22 miles of free trails and offers opportunities for the community to canoe and study the pristine ecosystems of the preserve. Plus, using earth friendly practices, ACLT's preserved farm land produces thousands of pounds of produce which are donated to local food pantries.
