AARP Tax-Aide Program

Certified Tax-Aide Counselors will be available at each Senior Center by appointment on February 2 to assist in the preparation and filing of individual Federal and State income tax returns. The program's focus is to assist low-to-moderate income citizens ages 50+.

Please gather the following:

- Full Federal and State tax returns for 2024
- Any IRS letters or amendments
- Wage, pension, bank, or other income statements
- Brokerage statements
- Records of medical expenses, mortgage payments, real estate taxes paid, and receipts for deductible charitable donations

Bring a canceled or voided check to verify your account for any electronic refunds or payments.
