## CHAPTER \_\_\_\_\_

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Calvert County – Alcoholic Beverages – Organizational Licenses**

3 FOR the purpose of establishing an organizational license in Calvert County;  
4 authorizing the license to be issued to a fraternal ~~or civic~~ organization,  
5 volunteer fire department, or volunteer rescue squad for use on certain  
6 premises; authorizing the licensee to sell beer, wine, and liquor by the drink for  
7 consumption on the licensed premises only; providing for an annual license fee  
8 of \$500; and generally relating to alcoholic beverages licenses in Calvert  
9 County.

10 BY repealing and reenacting, without amendments,  
11 Article 2B – Alcoholic Beverages

SQUAD FOR USE ON THE PREMISES THAT THE ORGANIZATION, FIRE  
DEPARTMENT, OR RESCUE SQUAD OWNS OR REGULARLY USES TO HOLD  
FUNCTIONS.

(III) A LICENSEE MAY SELL BEER, WINE, AND LIQUOR BY THE  
DRINK FOR CONSUMPTION ON THE LICENSED PREMISES ONLY.
